



Technology Agreement

The Foundry recognizes that, in our world today, technology is an integral part of both home and school environments. Because The Foundry wants students to have opportunities to learn using technology, we are permitting students to bring personal devices to school for instructional purposes only. The term “technology” covers hand-held and other mobile equipment such as tablets, netbooks, notebooks, laptops, or other systems that can be used for word processing, internet access, recording audio or video, or that may serve other purposes as deemed appropriate for a subject by the teacher. The owner of the personal technology is responsible for the safe-keeping, storage, updating, charging, and usage of the device. Devices should be labeled, and The Foundry is not liable for theft, loss, or damage.

All users of technology must agree to the following conditions:

- Students will abide by technology guidelines found in the Student and Parent Handbook.
- The technology must be used for instructional purposes only.
- If antivirus protection can be loaded on the device, it should be updated and in working order.
- Only The Foundry’s wireless network may be accessed.
- There will be no attempt to bypass the network filter or network security.
- Unauthorized recording of audio, pictures, or video is prohibited.
- The Foundry has the right to collect and examine any device that is suspected of causing problems on the network.
- The teacher is in charge of his/her classroom and can request at any time for personal technology be put away or shut down.
- A device will be surrendered for examination at any time upon request.
- The use of personal technology is a privilege, not a right, and can be revoked for misconduct.

I will abide by this agreement and understand that the privilege of bringing technology will be revoked and disciplinary actions may occur if I violate this agreement.
